Summer Freestyle Ice

**Note: These dates and times are subject to change with government restrictions.*

Mondays: 4-4:50 pm and 5-5:50 pm

Wednesdays: 3-3:50 pm and 4-4:50 pm

Dates: July 8th, 2020 - August 13th, 2020

Guidelines

- Prior to Entering the Arena
 - Arrive at the rink dressed in skating attire **with skates on** prior to entering the building (lockers rooms and benches will not be accessible at this time).
 - Warm-up and stretch outdoors. Skates can be put on in vehicle in parking lot. We ask that skate bags, etc be left in your vehicle.
 - One spectator per skater will be allowed into the arena. Skaters and spectators, please adhere to 140 Ice Den's protocol (attached).

- Upon Entering the Arena
 - Skaters may enter the arena five (5) minutes prior to the start of their designated practice session.
 - **As a courtesy to others and in accordance with recent updated state regulations, all patrons must wear a facial mask at all times they are in the arena. Exceptions include when skaters are jumping or spinning while skating.**
 - Skaters are to enter the ice adjacent to hockey benches opposite the stands (below "HOME" sign); Skaters are to exit the ice adjacent to locker room #2.
 - 6' spacings will be marked along the boards for placement of water bottles and other personal items. 6' markings will be drawn on the ice for coach/student location designation.
 - We ask skaters to remain a minimum of 6' apart on the ice and in the arena.

- Upon Exiting the Arena
 - Skaters will have five (5) minutes to exit the building once their session has ended.
 - Skates are to be removed at your vehicle (use of locker rooms and benches will not be allowed).

- Freestyle Session Guidelines
 - Freestyle capacity is limited to **15** skaters per session.
 - At this time, freestyle sessions will be limited to skaters in Basic 5 and above.
 - Freestyle sessions will be 50 minutes. This will allow for 10 minutes for skaters/chaperones to enter/exit the building between sessions. Half-hour sessions are not available for purchase at this time.
 - Freestyle session fees will remain at \$15 (per 50 minute session).
 - Session bookings and payment will be online only at [Livingston Skate Club](#). We will notify you when this is available.
 - Session bookings will be on a first come/ first serve basis with a 24-hour minimum cancellation policy. Cancellations made after the 24-hour period will be non-refundable.
 - All ice must be prepaid online. We will not have front desk staff accepting payment at this time for the safety of our club members.
 - Out of club skaters may book ice 48-hours prior to the start of the session.
 - Out of club cost - \$20 (per 50 minute session)
 - To reduce contact, the music playing area will be closed until further notice. For special circumstances, skater's may ask Elena or Kristen to play their music. When music area becomes reopened we plan to have all music on the LSC Ipad.

- Additional Information
 - If you are experiencing any symptoms of Covid-19, please do not enter the building. If you contract Covid-19 and have been to the arena within 4 days prior, please notify LSC immediately at livingstonskate@gmail.com.
 - Face Masks are required for the coaching staff.
 - Drinking fountains will not be in service at this time. Please bring your own beverage.
 - **This protocol is to be implemented immediately as our club returns to the ice. These guidelines are subject to change at any time.**
